





Pretrial Release Program Outcomes

	Program Range (Low – High)	Average
Issued a Warrant for Failing to Appear in Court	1% - 8%	4.4%
Arrested for Any Offense While in the Program	<1% - 13%	5.7%

Pretrial Release Program Participants Who Posted Bond

- 27 programs reported that judges could order bond for defendants in the program
- 37% of participants in programs posted bond



Pretrial Release Program Reporting Compliance

- 27 programs provided weekly registers to their Clerk of Court
- All 28 programs provided OPPAGA with their annual report
- 20 programs reported participants' prior criminal history
